CIS SHINES AT EDEXCEL AWARDS

CIS once again demonstrated its rich tradition of academic excellence as many students were recognised by Edexcel at this year's award ceremony. The exceptional performances of our students not only placed them among the top performers regionally and internationally, but also reinforced the school's long-standing heritage of nurturing high-achieving, disciplined, and ambitious learners.

The most impressive of these outstanding achievements came from Hirun Hettipathirana with two Best in Sri Lanka prizes for Chemistry and Physics, scoring a total of 2785 out of 2800 marks. Both Saarvesh and Soomin Lee achieved 5 A* grades and received awards for the highest performance at A2 level. Saarvesh secured a Best in Sri Lanka prize in Chemistry and Soomin won the Best in the World prize for Biology.

At IGCSE, 14 students won awards for achieving a grade 9 in seven or more subjects.

CIS has had great success at numerous sporting events this term including COMBOS Swimming, Cricket, Futsal as well as Sir John Tarbet All Island Athletics, International Schools Swimming and Basketball.



Liyara De Soysa won both the 50m and 100m Breaststroke events in the Under 14 category at the International Schools Swimming Tournament. In addition, Neoma Kahandawa placed 3rd in the 200M IM while Aavya Amarasinghe won 3rd place in 50m and 100m Butterfly.



At the Sir John Tarbet All Island Athletics Meet, Pereesha Totabadda became Under 13 and Under 14 Girls' Shot Putt Champion and set a national record. Meanwhile, Siluni Dihansa achieved a Merit Standard in the Under 15 Girls' High Jump. Liyana Karunarathne, Senumi Vijtharana and Jenuli Hettiarachchi were awarded Merit Standard in Girls' Leather Ball Throw, Girls' High Jump and Girls' Medicine Ball Throw respectively in the Under 12 category.

The Under 14 Girls became Champions in the COMBOS Futsal Tournament and the Under 19 Girls emerged Runners Up in the International Schools Basketball Tournament.
